The 5 groups were: Parkview Elementary School, Bible Church of Westville, Womens Club of Westville, and Westville United Methodist Church. Each of these groups qualified for the \$500.00 Gloucester County Clean Community Grant by participating in the clean-up. Wheelabrator provided coffee and donuts in the morning and lunch at 11:30. They also provided vests, gloves, pickers and bags, and no tipping fee for the trash collected. 720 lbs. of trash and 480 lbs. of recyclables were collected. Westville Public Works picked up the trash and recyclables from the various clean up locations.
