AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 79, ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES, ARTICLE I, LICENSED PREMISES; PUBLIC CONSUMPTION, SECTION 3, HOURS OF SALE, CLOSING OF PREMISES OF THE CODE BOOK OF THE BOROUGH OF WESTVILLE

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Westville, County of Gloucester and State of New Jersey that the governing body does hereby amend Chapter 79, Alcoholic Beverages, Article I, Licensed Premises; Public Consumption, Section 3, Hours of Sale, Closing of Premises of the Code of the Borough of Westville to read as follows:

Section 1. Hours of Sale, Closing of Premises.

A. Plenary Retail Consumption License

1. A licensee is hereby permitted to sell, serve or allow the consumption of any alcoholic beverage on licensed premises between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 2:00 a.m. on any day of the week except no licensee shall sell or delivery or allow or permit the sale or delivery of any liquor at retail in its original container for consumption off the premises or allow or permit the removal of any liquor in its original container before 9:00 am. or after 10:00 p.m. on any day of the week.

2. New Year's Day. No licensee shall sell, serve or delivery or allow or permit the sale, service or delivery of any alcoholic beverage or allow the consumption of any alcoholic beverage on the licensed premises on New Year's Day when it is a Monday through Saturday between the hours of 4:00 a.m. and 7:00 a.m. and on New Year's Day, when it is a Sunday, between the hours of 4:00 a.m. and 12:00 noon.

3. The hours above referred to shall be Eastern standard time.

B. Hours sales are prohibited. During the hours that sales are hereinabove prohibited, the entire licensed premises shall also be closed, but this closing-of-premises requirement shall not apply to bona fide hotels or to restaurants as defined in N.J.S.A. 33:1-1 et seq.

Section 2. Repealer

All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistencies.

Section 3. Severability

Each section of this Ordinance is an independent section, and the holding of any section or part thereof to be unconstitutional, void or ineffective, shall not be deemed to affect the validity or constitutionality of any other sections or parts hereof.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon formal approval by the Borough of Westville Borough Council and publication as required by law.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage and publication according to law.
