## CODE ENFORCEMENT JULY 2021 ACTIVITY REPORT

August 4, 2021

- Duncan Avenue – spoke with the church maintenance representative regarding the traffic cones that remain in the roadway after an event. We discussed the cones being removed from the roadway and sidewalk and to place them near the doors or inside of the church. He understood and removed them from the areas.
- High Street – pop-up tent on the front lawn and covering the sidewalk.

August 5, 2021

- Duncan Avenue – discharge of water across the sidewalk from inside of the building. D. Morina will send a Notice of Violations letter to the owner.
- Highland Avenue – report of raccoons residing in a vacant residence. Gloucester County Animal Control notified who set traps.
- Station Avenue – high weeds and grass, 2<sup>nd</sup> notice of violation sent.
- Summit Avenue – follow-up from fire at the residence and debris on the lawn. Owner contacted to clean all debris from the property.
