September 7, 2021

- Broadway – parking block obstructing the sidewalk, requested the owner to move the parking block.
- Cedar Avenue – pool in the rear yard without permits.
- Crown Point Road – two vehicles remained in the rear yard after warnings, ordinance issued.

September 8, 2021

- Almonesson Road – overgrowth of tree and weeds onto Delsea Drive, spoke with the owner to trim or remove the growth.
