WASTE COLLECTION - 2026 UPDATE

Dear Resident,

This information has been prepared for your convenience in understanding Westville's trash and recycling regulations. Help reduce incinerator fees by recycling. Recycling cans are available. Should you have any questions, please feel free to call the Public Works office at 856-456-7785, Monday through Friday, 8:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. We hope this information will be useful to you. Thank you for your cooperation.

TRASH & RECYCLING COLLECTION SCHEDULE

Collections may be interrupted by observed holidays. Please see Holiday schedule below or call for any questions.

MONDAY: Entire town will have special waste collected on 1st & 3rd Monday of month.

TUESDAY: Ambler Ave, Avon Ave, Birch Ave, Cedar Ave, Center St, Cypress Ct, Duncan Ave, E. Olive St (to Delsea), Harvard Ave (Residential), High St, Lehigh Ave, Locust Ave, New St, Oak Ave, Pine St, Spruce Ave, State Rd, Walnut St, Willow Ave, Woodbine Ave (By Railroad), and Yale Ave

WEDNESDAY: Almonesson Rd, Burr Ave, Center Street (By Edgewater), Deadline Dr, Delsea Dr, Dewey Ave, E. Olive St (To Almonesson Rd), Edgewater Ave, Harvard Ave (Industrial), Hillside Ave, Hunter Ave, Klinger Ave, Maple Ave, Parkview Dr, Parkview Cir, Poplar Ave, Snyder Ave, Stanley Ave, Timber Ave, Twedell Ave, and West Ave

FRIDAY: Chestnut St, Cleveland Ave, Crown Point Rd, Delaware View Ave, Elm St, Fifth Ave, Folsom Ave, Fourth Ave, Gateway Blvd, Hazel Ave, Highland Ave, Little Chestnut St, Park Ave, River Dr, Sixth Ave, Station Ave, Summit Ave, Third Ave, W. Olive St, Woodbine Ave

Items to be TRASHED:

Regular household waste, any painted/stained wood, grass clippings, mulch, dried out latex and oil paints, leaves from mid-December to mid-October

Items to be RECYCLED:

Newspapers, magazines, telephone books, corrugated, cardboard cereal boxes, plastics (which includes soda bottles), household detergents, water/milk containers, etc.), glass bottles and jars (all colors). Tin, aluminum, & bi-metallic cans (**items rinsed of food products and caps removed**). See lid of recycling containers for acceptable items.

****NO PLASTIC BAGS - Any size/color****

**** NO SHREDDED PAPER****

**** NO PIZZA BOX'S - Oily contaminates ****

Recyclable items must be placed in a blue recycling can. No other items will be collected from blue cans.

All items will be collected from the curb line and should be placed no earlier than 6:00pm on the evening before your scheduled collection day. Cans not at the curb by 7:00am on collection day may not be collected. All containers should be removed from the curb line by 7:00pm the day of collection.

Vegetative Waste Ex. weeds, flower, shrubbery	Loose in a can, neatly tied at curb, in a paper yard waste bag	1st & 3rd Monday of the Month *Seasonal Changes
Tree Branches, Unpainted Wood	Cut in no larger than 5 ft. sections not heavier than 50 lbs., neatly tied at curb	1st & 3rd Monday of the Month *Seasonal Changes
Grass Clippings Do NOT blow into street!	Loose in can or bagged with trash, do not mix with yard waste	Regular Trash Day
Leaves mid-December to mid-October	Loose in can or bagged with trash, do not mix with yard waste	Regular Trash Day *Seasonal Changes
Metal Items & Appliances	Place at curblane, fridge & freezer doors must be removed	1st & 3rd Monday of the Month
Tires & Batteries Personal cars & trucks ONLY	Place at curblane, no more than 4 tires	1st & 3rd Monday of the Month
Concrete, Bricks, Cinder Blocks	Places chunks at curb or in containers, not more than 50 lbs per piece/container	1st & 3rd Monday of the Month
Large Articles Ex. sofas, mattress, rug, dresser	Place at curb, mattresses should be bagged	1st & 3rd Monday of the Month
Electronics Ex. TVs, computers, monitors	Place at curb	1st & 3rd Monday of the Month
Textile Recycling Program	Place in weatherproof bag obtained from DPW at curb. Call to obtain bag.	2nd Monday of the Month
Hazardous Waste Ex) motor oil, fuels, pesticides	Not accepted	See Household Hazardous Waste Collection section below

SEASONAL COLLECTIONS CHANGES – Entire Town

Collections may be interrupted by observed holidays. Please see Holiday schedule below or call for any questions.

MATERIAL	SPECIAL SEASON & INSTRUCTIONS	DAYS OF COLLECTION
Vegetative Waste Ex. weeds, flower, shrubbery	May through September	Every Monday
Tree Branches, Unpainted Wood	May through September	Every Monday
Leaves	mid-October to mid-December Rake to curb, do not bag	Please call for current schedule, schedule posted on Facebook too
Leaves	Spring Clean Up Rake to curb, do not bag	1 week in Spring as designated by DPW, please call for schedule

NOTE THE FOLLOWING:

- Trash mixed with recyclables will not be collected until separated. Recycling cans being used for non-recyclable will not be collected. It will be collected on the next regularly scheduled day.
- Recyclable materials must be placed in a blue can, recycling cans are available through the borough.
- Waste containers and loose waste should not exceed the 50 pound weight limit.
- Homeowners should recycle their grass clippings by using them around trees, plants and bushes for mulch or leave on lawn or can be disposed in regular trash.
- Do not rake leaves onto/within 10 ft of a storm drain or blow grass clippings into the street. This violates the Federal Storm Water regulations that imposes fines for violations.
- Public Works will not collect trash from private contractors or trash generated from outside of town.
- Roof shingles, dirt, and hazardous waste are not accepted by the landfill or incinerator. The resident or contractor must dispose of properly.
- Collections may be interrupted by observed holidays.

HOLIDAYS: When a holiday falls on a Monday, there will be **no collection** of large articles, vegetative waste, leaves, etc. for that week. Please see the below chart for the dates Public Works will observe holidays in 2026. ***Public Works' holidays may be observed on a different day than Borough offices.*

Labor Day	9/7/26 (Mon.)	Special collections are cancelled.
Columbus Day	10/12/26 (Mon.)	No change.
Veteran's Day	11/9/26 (Mon.)	No change.
Thanksgiving Day	11/26/26 (Thur.)	No Change.
Christmas Day	12/25/26 (Fri.)	Friday's trash and recycling will be collected 12/28/26 (Mon.).

HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE COLLECTION:

Hazardous waste is collected by the county. Please call the Office of Recycling at 856-478-6045 for free event dates and information. Event information can also be found online at www.gcianj.com. Materials accepted for disposal at various Gloucester County waste complexes throughout the year:

Clothing/Textile Recycling Program:

- Place gently used clothing/textiles into a plastic bag, then place that bag into the weatherproof bag provided. We will deliver another carryall to every house that places one at the curb line the **2nd Monday of each month** or by request to begin participating in the program. If Monday is a Holiday, collection will be the next day-Tuesday. Donation boxes are also available for use at any time located at the **Public Work's Garage** on Crown Point Rd, at **Parkview Elementary School** on Birch Ave, and at the **Senior Center** on Broadway.

Snow Removal:

- Plowing will commence when three or more inches have accumulated.
- Use driveways and refrain from parking in the alleys. If a vehicle is blocking an alley or street, we may be unable to plow the area.
- Refrain from clearing driveway aprons until Public Works has cleared the street.
- Do not blow or shovel snow into the street.

PLEASE CONSERVE WATER:

It is best to water very early in the morning or later in the evening. We recommend that if your house number is odd, water on odd calendar days; even numbered houses should water on even days. Please continue to conserve water. Westville Borough ~ thanking you in advance for your cooperation.
